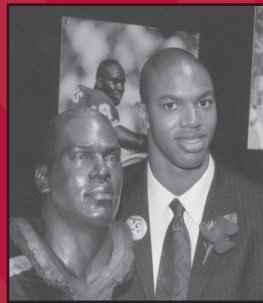


**GOLF CO-CHAIR:

Like his Hall of Fame father, Derrion wants to be known for his accomplishments both on and off the football field. Following two years at Fort Scott (Kan.) Community College, Derrion enrolled at the University of Missouri and will play defensive end for the Tigers. During his senior season at Blue Springs South High School, Derrion flashed signs of his late

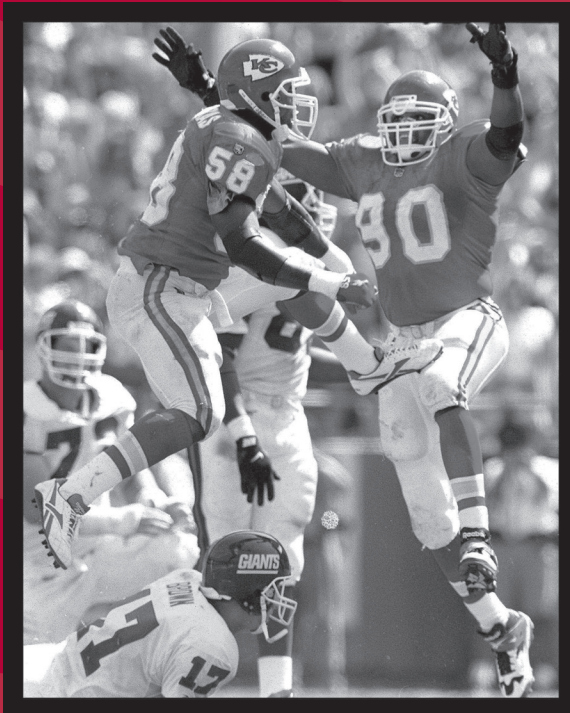
father's greatness. In a state quarterfinal game against Rockhurst, he sacked then-Hawkleys and current University of Illinois quarterback Nathan Scheelhaase four times in the Jaguars 14-9 win. He finished his senior year (the only full season of high school football he played) with 53 tackles, 11 sacks and three forced fumbles and earned first-team honors on the Class 6 Missouri Sportswriters and Sportscasters Association all-state team. "I'm sure Derrion will leave Columbia a better place than he found it," long time family friend Kevin Regan told the Columbia Daily Tribune newspaper. "He makes every environment he's participated in better."

Otis Taylor, III



Otis Taylor, III is dedicated to working with area youth, just like his father, Otis Taylor, Jr., former All-Pro wide receiver for the Kansas City Chiefs and long-time board member of the Derrick Thomas/Neil Smith Third and Long Foundation. Otis III attended Missouri Southern State University in Joplin and graduated from Mid America Nazarene in Olathe

with a bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice. He played wide receiver at both universities while earning a trip to the NAIA Football Championship Series with the Pioneers in 2009. Because of his skills and athletic ability, several professional football teams including the Chiefs, the Buffalo Bills and the Florida Tuskers of the United Football League (UFL) brought Otis III to their facilities. He is currently a case manager for Gillis, a Kansas City-based organization helping troubled children and their families become healthy and self-sufficient, and he coaches football at Ruskin High School. Like his father before him, Otis III provides guidance and positive opportunities to the youth of Kansas City.
